95/17 Local Business Economy

Councillor P Kendall referred to the forthcoming closure of a factory in Annan, advising that as well as affecting the economy in that area, there would be an impact on the Maryport economy through resident employees of the factory & the supply chain. Councillor Kendall reported that he had spoken with representatives of Annan Town Council to seek to establish the background to the success of its local economy. His findings were that whilst the town did not have a Chamber of Trade, it had a vibrant group of self-motivated traders who worked together with an entrepreneurial spirit. The representatives suggested that the Town Council seek to establish a similar group in Maryport. Councillor Kendall reported that funding should be available from the Borderlands Fund, & that Annan would be holding a local event day, the Riding of the Marches, later in the year, which he had obtained agreement to representatives from the Council attending, to facilitate promotion of Maryport.

Resolved that the Council seek to formalise its arrangements with Annan Town Council & that support be given to promotional work of Maryport by Council members at the Riding of the Marches event to be held in Annan.
