# Presentation from Allerdale Borough Council Car Park Manager Mike Hall & Executive member Mike Heaslip regarding proposals for changes to charging arrangements

Following a review of car parking charges for off-street car parking, Allerdale Borough Council was consulting on proposed changes to its arrangements. The proposed changes were based on a town by town analysis, rather than being a district wide system. An analysis of its economic operations had led to a recommendation that Mill Street Car Park be made available free of charge from the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016 for an unlimited period.

Allerdale representatives agreed to take into account in their proposals other Allerdale land used for parking in Maryport, such as that by The Wave & on Senhouse Street by The Golden Lion, as well as linking in with Cumbria County Council arrangements for on-street car parking management.

**Resolved** that the proposals for Maryport be welcomed.
