66/13 Apologies for Absence

69/13 Minutes of Meeting held on 28 October 2013

Resolved that the minutes of the meeting of the Planning & Economic Development Committee held on 28 October 2013 be confirmed as a correct record & signed by the Chairman.

70/13 Maryport Town Centre Development

A presentation was received from Allerdale Borough Council Town Centre Manager for Maryport, Toni Magean, setting out the work that he had been involved in over the previous year or so. Mr Magean advised that much of the developmental work emanated from a report commissioned from the Hidden Britain Group, which had, through a community workshop, a mystery shopping event, & a marketing audit, reviewed the existing & potential support for tourism in Maryport, through identifying strengths & weaknesses in the town. A report, 'Tourism Development in Maryport', was produced, which contained recommendations on improvements to be made over the short, medium & long terms.

A group called the 'Town Team' was formed from the group of interested parties who had addressed the Hidden Britain reports, with the aim of continuing the work, under the flag of the 'Love Maryport' logo developed a few years ago. The Town Team was identified by Mr Magean as the means by which the secondary funding obtained through the Mary Portas Scheme bid, £10,000, supported by £10,000 from Allerdale Borough Council & £3,000 from Maryport Town Council, should be channelled into the town. The scope of the funding criteria was deemed sufficiently wide by Mr Magean to facilitate the use of the funding to address issues raised in the Hidden Britain reports, & the Town Team was supporting, developing & funding schemes in that respect, including:

- 1) A mosaic for Maryport, to be displayed on Senhouse Street.
- 2) A town website & supporting smart mobile phone application.
- 3) A 'My Cumbrian' card.
- 4) Town centre maps & navigational aid.
- 5) A town information booklet.
- 6) Heritage Trails.
- 7) Improved & co-ordinated signage.

The Town Team was not a constituted group, but was intended to develop as such. In addition to work done with the Town Team, Mr Magean had established quarterly walkabouts, which were intended to identify issues in Maryport which required to be addressed, & reports were produced setting out these issues, together with the party responsible for each identified issue. He had worked with Cumbria in Bloom &, following the successful display results in Maryport in 2013, involving various parties, recommended that a lead party be established. He had worked with members of the community on a town centre clean up on one day during the summer & had worked with the Solway Trust on two occasions to help clean-up Maryport promenade.

Mr Magean was working with the Town Team to develop the schemes previously noted, & provide general support to town centre businesses, through regular contact, provision of newsletters & ongoing support. He referred to 'Small Business Saturday', which was being promoted through Allerdale Borough Council & which he was providing a presentation for on 4 December. He was also working with certain businesses to form package deals for visitors.

Resolved that Mr Magean be thanked for his presentation & that a copy of a letter, distributed by the Town Council in 2012, in support of a Traders' Group scheme to encourage the improved presentation of the town centre through the introduction of hanging baskets & Christmas lighting improvements, be provided for an interested member of the business community in the town.
