The application also contained a number of factual errors, such as availability of off-street parking, and the two proposed uses were not considered compatible. Maryport already had a number of licensed premises and it was believed that the proposal would not benefit the economy of the town, The building was not considered big enough to hold 400 people, as proposed, and was not big enough to include a celebration room & kitchen space for food preparation as well as a bar area. The Council had received three copies of a

letter to Allerdale Borough Council Planning Services from Mr & Mrs Barkhouse of King Street, Maryport, two of which they requested to be forwarded to Allerdale Borough Council members lain Greaney & Adrian Kirkbride.
