# 30/22 Presentation from Mary Bradley, Allerdale Geological Disposal Facility Partnership

The Chairman of the Allerdale Geological Disposal Partnership, Mary Bradley, gave a presentation on the operations of the partnership & the potential impact of a nuclear disposal facility in the area, as well as the availability of community funding provided in conjunction with the considerations. The partnership is investigating the community's willingness to host a disposal facility in the area.

Testing has been underway out at sea and locally to identify the presence of suitable rock to host a facility. The facility must be sustainable & the stored materials must not come into contact with water. The investigation is expected to take some 18 months from start to finish, including the analysis of findings. £1 million is available to the community from this project, with 19 grants having been given out so far.

An open day will be held in Maryport Rugby Club on 29<sup>th</sup> September where subject matter experts will be available to answer all questions.
